The Saratoga Room



This pleasant room has a wonderful bay window view of Jackson Street. It features a queen sized bed with

You have created a paradise by the sea—your home is truly the best—you cook better than Mom and I can’t say enough about your hospitality—see you next year!

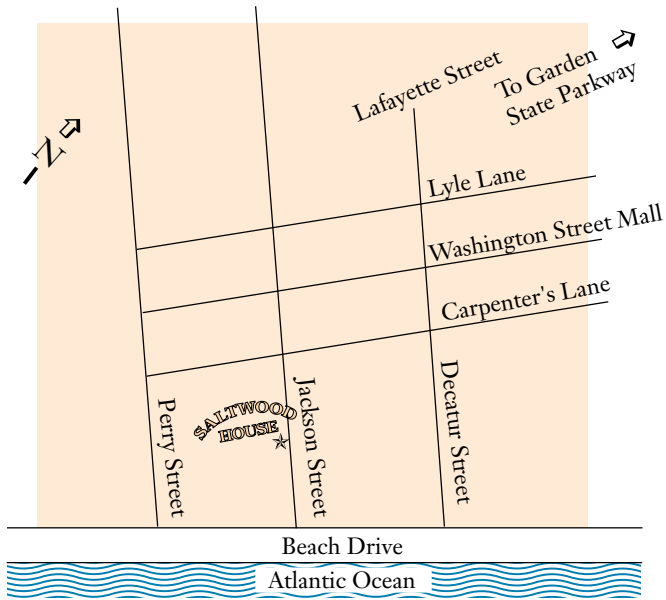

Saltwood House is easy to find. Follow Lafayette Street (*the main thoroughfare into town*) until it ends. Turn left on Jackson Street. Pass the walking Mall on Washington Street. Proceed another $\frac{1}{2}$ block and you are there.
